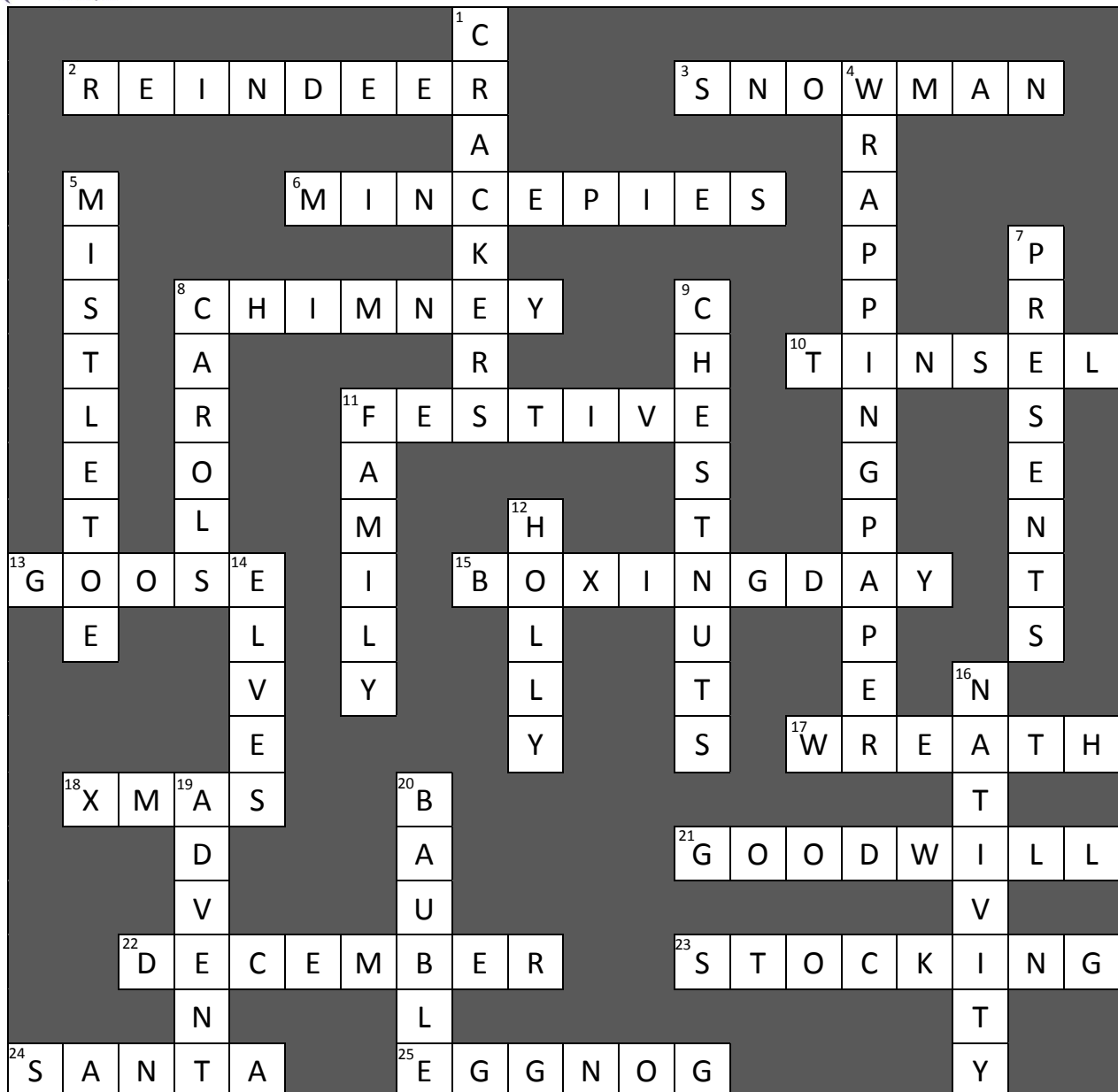


Christmas Crossword
